Skin by Melyn Focuses on Health and Beauty

Skin: It's the largest organ of the human body and, according to Melyn Bellatti, LE, owner of Skin by Melyn, it is incredibly important to remove, rebuild, protect, and maintain healthy skin to serve as protection for a person's immune system, as well as from environmental and physical damage.

Melyn is passionate about helping educate people on skin health, which in turn helps their overall health.



Russell Chiropractic There to Treat Your Pain

It all happens so fast. You may see it coming but not be able to prevent it. You hear the screeching of tires and then BAM! Hours, days, weeks, and even months later the pain from the accident comes.

"Chiropractic care can provide a drug-free way to relieve pain," said Dr. Tracy Russell, a chiropractor and physician who has more than 27 years of successful experience in preventative healthcare. He is also trained in the diagnosis and treatment of many different spinal injuries, as well as shoulder, hand, and foot problems.

The force of an auto accident can knock the musculoskeletal system out of proper alignment. Back and neck pain, as well as pain in the hands and feet, can occur as a result.

Another example of a possible injury can occur when using a computer keyboard for long periods of time or writing a letter. Carpal Tunnel Syndrome is a condition that can cause pain, numbness, and tingling sensations in the hand. Left untreated, it can worsen over time.

"Proper alignment by a trained hand and foot chiropractor is truly getting to the root cause of the underlying problem. Even if surgery has already been attempted and failed, joint manipulation is still an option for patients suffering with CTS," said Dr. Russell.

Only a chiropractor can tell if a patient can benefit from chiropractic care. It starts with an initial exam, x-rays and consultation.



"With our specialized examination techniques, we are able to ferret out joints that are dysfunctional," said Dr. Russell. "By rendering chiropractic adjustments to the necessary joints, proper motion can be restored and healing can begin to take place."

On a patient's first visit, Dr. Russell will discuss the symptoms and previous injuries, family health history, and lifestyle, including recreational and work-related physical activities.

Because all the bones from a person's head to their feet are connected, alignment can affect overall proper function.

"Your feet are like the foundation of a house," Dr. Russell explained. "If there is a misalignment in one or more of the 26 bones in the foot, then more problems — and pain — can occur in other places, such as the knee, hip, back, shoulder or neck. Studies have shown 85 percent of people with foot pain also have low back pain and three out of four people can't exercise due to their foot pain."



Repentance

The Mystery of God Consuming Your Heart

Repentance is a powerful word repeated in scripture. Typically, the Hebrew word for repentance is *teshuvah*, which means 'to return' or to 'turn about.' But in Hebrew, there is so much more about this word.

When we repent, we are not only returning to God, but also creating room for Him in our hearts. We are turning away from the sin that keeps us separated from His presence.

In Hebrew, there are other meanings for the word we translate as 'repentance.' It also means...

- To consume
- To press down
- To destroy
- To burn up

Have you ever prayed Psalm 51?

"Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and uphold me by Your generous Spirit."—Psalm 51:10-12

This psalm is King David's cry of repentance.

Repentance | The Mystery of Blotting out What was Recorded

In the psalm, David acknowledges his transgressions, iniquity and sin. He makes no excuse and understands his sin is against the Lord. He asks God to wash away the stain of sin, to blot them out as if they are written in a book.

He is petitioning the Lord to remove any record of his iniquity after His heart aches in godly sorrow.

Repentance | The Mystery of the Holy Spirit's Fire

Another remarkable mystery is revealed here. He mentions the Holy Spirit in verse 11. The Holy Spirit is described in scripture as a burning and consuming fire.

God instructs His people to keep the fire burning on the altar.

- "A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out."—Leviticus 6:13

In other words, God instructs us to never allow the Holy Spirit's fire to go out in our lives. When we welcome the Spirit's fire into our lives, He burns up anything that keeps us apart from God. As we keep His fire burning on the altars of our hearts, He consumes the fiery darts of the enemy.

So then, what do you want the Holy Spirit to press upon your heart today? Perhaps there is something you need burned up in your life so that you will never return to it again.

The Final Mystery of Repentance

When you truly repent with godly sorrow in your heart, ask the Holy Spirit to come and consume every lasting effect of the iniquity. If it is not completely consumed or surrendered to God on the altar of your heart, there will be residue of it left in your life.

That residue is like a tail following you. The enemy tries to catch it and pull you back into your old ways.

But friend, remember this: "...the Lord will make you the head, and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God..." (Deut. 28:13).

In short, embrace His instructions and welcome His fire because Christ wants to rule in your heart.
