

Guns of Glory Grand Opening Scheduled for Sept. 17 & 18

Guns of Glory is opening September 17-18 with special events, vendors, drawings, and giveaways. On September 20-21 they will be the hosting sponsors of Blue Life Support Seminar, with assistance from the Bartlesville Police Department and the Bartlesville Community Center.

The Guns of Glory Proshop and Indoor Range is located at 427 S. Osage Ave., in Dewey, and the Outdoor Range is a few miles away at 402643 US Highway 60 in rural Bartlesville.

The Grand Opening event on the 17th and 18th will be action-packed days, starting at 10 a.m. and going until 7 p.m.

Instructors from across the United States will be on hand to offer advice, demonstrations, and training on the safe and effective handling of firearms.

Kara Gage, Guns of Glory's Executive Marketing/Creative Director and Lead Instructor, is an NRA Training Counselor, Chief Range Safety Officer, and an Oklahoma SDA instructor. She is excited about the grand opening celebration and all the special instructors who are helping.

Israel "Izzy" Mantos with Defensive Marksmanship Instructor Group, Maggie Mordaunt and Ken Ortega with Homeland Personal Protection, and Ben Morgan with Battleline Tactical are just a few of the specialists who are participating.

"Most people know how to shoot or how a gun works, but it is important to know how to properly fight with a gun," said Morgan. "I can help people choose the best gun for how they plan to use it. Will the gun be for everyday defense or home defense?"

"I want to make sure people are going through the proper gun buying process and not just buying something because of the price tag or because they saw it on TV."

Morgan, who is a former Army Ranger and Infantry officer, also specializes in self-defense and life-saving skills.

Guns of Glory's Owner, Daniel Dawson, is passionate about helping learn about self-defense and firearms. "As a Christian, it hurts my heart to see bad people taking advantage of innocent, law-abiding citi-



zens. God gives us permission in the Bible to protect ourselves and others," said Daniel. "I wanted to open a facility that would allow people the opportunity to practice using their firearms, so they could be more confident and accurate should the need ever arise."

He also wanted to have a place where people who didn't know anything about firearms could be trained and build confidence in handling them safely and shooting them proficiently, so their fears about firearms would subside.

"I offer training for people who want to be able to defend themselves and others from criminals who do not follow laws," said Daniel. "Better to have a firearm and not need one than need one and not have it or know how to use it."

A few years ago, Daniel shared his dream of owning a firearm business with his mother, who helped him get started. Sadly, his mother got COVID-19 and passed away in March 2020.

"It is my dream to finish the last project that we started together and ensure the success she believed I was capable of achieving," he said. "To this day, I hope — since happy is all God allows us to be in Heaven — that He might let her look down on this business and it's success so she can be happy about what we started."

As the lead instructor at Guns Of Glory, Kara has a true passion for teaching self-defense. This passion stems from her past experiences. "I'm a victim, turned survivor, turned loud-mouthed advocate against

domestic violence," she said. "My ex said he would win no matter what, so a girl who was afraid of guns decided to get one. I ended up becoming an instructor then decided that type of training wasn't good enough, so I sought more and more and more training. Even if I never helped anyone else, I want to ensure not one of my four daughters will know what it is like to be a victim."

She's a strong-willed advocate for others, especially women. "As a single mom, being able to protect yourself and those you love is important, I never knew that God would use my decision of marrying a bad guy to enable me to teach people nationwide. Here I am now at this little place in Dewey, Oklahoma," she said.

Daniel is hopeful that as people learn more about firearms safety and handling, they can find the fun and joy in shooting a tiny hole accurately through a target all the way down range.

"There is a reason it's a sport," he said. "It takes skill. When you learn a skill, you can take pride in your new abilities and feel more confident in yourself. This is what brings joy to people when they shoot. I want to spread the joy I have when I shoot that tiny target downrange, with my tiny bullet, into the hearts of everyone who visits Guns of Glory."

We will close this story with Guns of Glory's logo. Daniel served in the Army as an infantryman, the logo has crossed infantry rifles, surrounded by the crown of thorns. That's what Guns Of Glory is all about: God, Guns & Country!

Lavers Now Offering IPL Treatments

Intense Pulse Light Targets Skin Discoloration

Lavers Aesthetics has expanded their services to include Intense Pulse Light Treatments.

IPL treatments target skin discoloration, rosacea, melasma, and hyper-pigmentation. These treatments use multiple waves of light to target and break down the unwanted spots in the skin. A handheld device is used to deliver light therapy.

"During the procedure, you may feel what some individuals have described as a feeling similar to an elastic band being 'snapped' on the skin," said Chris Lavers, PA-C, who owns Lavers Aesthetics along with his wife, Cory. "The length and number of sessions needed will depend on each individual's treatment plan."

Lavers Aesthetics also offers thread lifts to tighten and lift sagging skin. Dissolvable threads provide an alternative way to treat skin laxity on the face and body that has only been achievable in the past by plastic surgery. The cost is much more affordable, and since there is no downtime, this treatment is perfect for those who do not want to undergo surgery or who have seen little effect from skin tightening treatments.

A thread lift is a procedure that uses temporary sutures to produce a subtle but visible "lift" in the skin. Instead of removing the sagging skin, threads lift the skin, causing it to become smoother and tighter. They also promote collagen formation around the threads, positively influencing the overall condition of the skin. As we age, we produce less and less collagen. This leads to a reduction of skin thickness by 80 percent at the age of 70, but the effects of this process are seen for decades before. Threads are part of an effective regimen to correct the signs of aging.

As always, Lavers Aesthetics also offers injectable neuromodulators such as Botox and Xeomin for fine lines and wrinkles; dermal fillers such as Revanesse Versa+ for adding volume to the lips, cheeks, tear troughs, chin, and jawline; and non-surgical injectable body contouring for the treatment of double chin or other unwanted deposits of body fat.

These treatments alone or together can help to create a more youthful appearance

Advice for a Healthier Back

A local orthopedic physician wants to help educate people about reducing or eliminating pain and restoring a healthy back.

Dr. Kris Parchuri, a spinal surgeon with offices in Bartlesville and Tulsa, specializes in bringing the best possible procedure and treatment to every patient by connecting with them on a personal and professional level. His offices, Spine & Orthopedic Specialists, are located at 226 SE DeBell Ave., Bartlesville, in the building on the north side of the parking lot, and in Tulsa at 8165 S. Mingo Rd., Ste. 201.

"The key to treatment of spinal injuries is prevention," said Dr. Parchuri. "Not only is it important to maintain good core strength, but it is imperative to always use proper lifting technique. Neck and back injuries can occur regardless of our age, so we need to be smart about the risk we take with activities."

Dr. Parchuri is a proud graduate of Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences College of Osteopathic Medicine. He completed his orthopedic residency in Tulsa at Oklahoma State University Medical Center, followed by a spine fellowship at Texas Back Institute in Plano, Texas.

With more than 13 years of professional experience in orthopedic surgery and orthopedic surgery of the spine, Dr. Parchuri has been practicing in the area since 2010. While he specializes in treating spine-related diseases and disorders, his practice area also includes general orthopedics. Dr. Parchuri treats all types of fractures, as well as conditions related to the shoulder, elbow, hand, hip, knee, foot and ankle.

When you are experiencing pain involving your spine, Dr. Parchuri offers this advice: "Listen to your body. Fortunately, most neck and back injuries are muscular. Being so, they will resolve with rest and sometimes use of anti-inflammatories such as ibuprofen. If the pain does not resolve in 7-10 days or starts to shoot down the arms or legs, get a medical evaluation soon. There might be a more serious underlying condition."

What type of medical professional can help evaluate you for a spinal injury? "There are many health care providers that can offer the initial evaluation and work up. These include your primary care, chiropractor, or a physical therapist. These individuals will usually offer conservative options, non-surgical, prior to making a referral," Dr. Parchuri said.

At the office of Dr. Parchuri, a team of medical professionals is ready to help you get your life back today. If you are suffering from chronic or acute pain, you need the leading medical professional in Tulsa spinal surgery. He is committed, dedicated, specializes in orthopedic spine surgery and pain management, and is ready to exceed your expectations with the very best service and treatment. Dr. Parchuri can put you on the road to recovery and help you reclaim your life.

Dr. Parchuri said many people are scared or anxious to visit with a spine surgeon, because they believe the surgeon will want to operate.

"Unfortunately, this is a myth perpetuated by non-facts," he said. "Most surgeons will only recommend surgery when it is absolutely needed and when all other non-surgical options have failed. Typically, in my practice, less than 10 percent of the patients I see on a weekly basis end up needing surgery," Dr. Parchuri said. "Also, technology has dramatically changed in that fusions are quickly becoming a thing of the past. My practice is one of the leaders in performing artificial



disk replacements of the cervical and lumbar spine. This allows for a much faster recovery and essentially no loss of motion. Our professional staff prides itself on listening to each patient to ensure they receive the correct treatment."

Dr. Parchuri and his team have the advanced clinical training and education to ensure that you receive the best care for your pain. "We focus on more than just the problem," said Dr. Parchuri. "We focus on each patient as a whole and as an individual, giving you the attention you need and deserve to start moving forward in your life."

Examples of some of the outpatient procedures he offers include disc replacement, microdiscectomy, and fusions.

Disc replacement involves replacing a worn or degenerated disk in your spine with an artificial disk made of metal or a combination of metal and plastic. The benefits of disc replacement include faster recovery times and improved range of motion. Disc replacement is generally seen as cutting-edge technology and an alternative to the more common spinal fusion surgery.

Microdiscectomy is a minimally invasive surgical procedure performed on patients with a herniated disc. During this surgery, Dr. Parchuri removes portions of the herniated disc to relieve pressure on the spinal nerve column. Spinal surgery once meant large incisions, long recovery periods, and painful rehab. Fortunately, surgical advances like the microdiscectomy procedure have improved the process to patients, requiring less than a 1-inch incision and having the procedure performed on an outpatient basis.

Spinal fusions involve removing the problematic disc and replacing it with a bone graft or bone graft substitute to allow the adjacent vertebrae to eventually fuse together. Technological advancements have allowed these procedures to now be done with minimally invasive technique allowing for a quicker recovery and improved results.

Dr. Parchuri also specializes in the diagnosis and treatment for SI joint disease and dysfunction.

If non-surgical therapy fails to provide lasting relief, Dr. Parchuri and his patients may consider surgical options. The iFuse Implant System is a minimally invasive treatment option to treat some SI joint disorders. The titanium iFuse Implants are surgically inserted to fuse the joint and eliminate pain.


