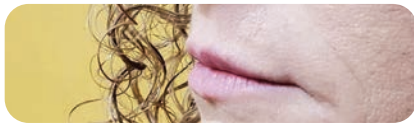

Instructor Eric Fuson, an International Defensive Pistol Association (IDPA) national championship winner, said he is happy to be a part of the Guns of Glory team.

"I'm really excited to be doing what I truly love — one-on-one sales and training with my customers," said Eric. "Recreational shooting and training are fun for the whole family."

Eric has more than 20 years of experience in the firearms industry in sales and customer service. He has achieved many high rankings in competition and has been a professional firearms instructor since 2004. He is classified by IDPA as a Distinguished Master, because he has "made a great personal commitment to reaching the very highest levels of skill and proficiency with a handgun," according to IDPA. To reach this level a competitor must have spent considerable time and effort at refining their abilities. As such, the requirements for being inducted into this classification are very stringent.

Eric has more than 70 state, regional, and national championship wins in IDPA and

more than a dozen in the United States Practical Shooting Association (USPSA).

"I am a passionate outdoorsman, hunter, and fisherman, and have also been active in archery, primitive arms, and shotgun competitions over the years," said Eric.

He has held armorer's certificates for Glock, Smith and Wesson, Remington, and Colt (1911 and AR15).

Eric has two primary firearms that he uses. The first is the CQB Elite in 9mm and .45 with adjustable rear sight, fiber optic front, 30LPI checkering under the trigger guard, and a standard speed chute magazine well. The second is a custom-built STI 2011 with all Wilson Combat parts in .40 cal fixed sights fiber optic.

Guns of Glory offers several ways to shoot at their indoor range. They have just introduced their brand-new punch cards for either six- or 12-lane passes, that can be shared with whomever the purchaser chooses and have no expiration date. 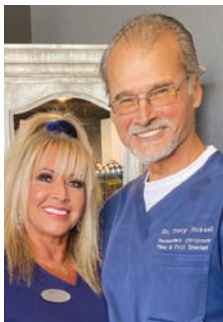

About Dealing with Pain in Your Feet

Is Plantar fasciitis slowing you down?

Local youth Devon Smith used to suffer from a condition called plantar fasciitis. In fact, at the age of 8, Devon could hardly walk and was facing the prospect of having surgery. Plantar fasciitis refers to a chronic local inflammation of the thick band of tissue stretching underneath the sole (plantar fascia) that attaches to the heel. Most of the time, it is caused by a recurring strain injury to the ligament of the sole.

"Plantar fasciitis is one of the most common orthopedic complaints, because your plantar fascia ligament experiences a lot of wear and tear," said Dr. Russell. "It affects millions of Americans and it can be very painful and debilitating."

If foot pain is disrupting your daily life, then Dr. Russell is ready to assist you. "Our chiropractic clinic offers unique expertise on treating many different foot conditions," he said.

On the bottom of your foot there is a strong, elastic ligament that spans from your heel bone all the way to your five toes. That ligamentous tissue is known as the plantar fascia.

There are 26 bones in each foot. These 26 bones are arranged into four arches, two lengthwise and two widthwise. When you stand and walk the plantar fascia provides support and gives flexibility to the arches of the foot. "Activities such as prolonged standing, walking or running on rough, uneven terrain or up/down hill, and even pregnancy can cause the foot bones to lose their healthy alignment," said Dr. Russell. "When the 26 bones of the foot become misaligned this will cause a twisting force or abnormal stress to the plantar fascia."

The added stress may cause the plantar fascia to become overstretched and irritated, and its fibers can even tear. This condition is known as plantar fasciitis. It can produce mild to moderate pain and it commonly becomes severe and disabling when left untreated.

"Chiropractic adjustments to the 26 foot bones is very helpful in relieving stress from the plantar fascia and other parts of the foot,"



said Dr. Russell. "Patients who suffer with plantar fasciitis usually respond very well to our treatment."

According to the American Podiatric Medical Association, 72 percent of people will suffer from significant foot pain during their lifetime. "There is a huge need for chiropractic foot care," said Dr. Russell. "Our chiropractic clinic is amongst the top in the nation for providing foot adjustments and foot care. 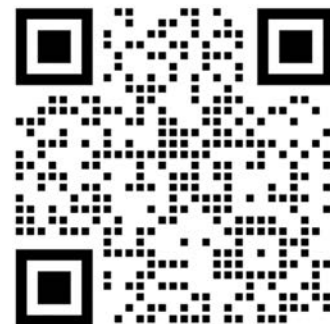
Plantar fasciitis commonly causes stabbing pain that usually occurs with your first steps in the morning. As you get up and move, the pain normally decreases, but it might return after long periods of standing or when you stand up after sitting.

He can adjust your ankles, feet, knees, hips, and spine to alleviate pressure on the bottom of your feet, reducing foot pain and promoting healing. These stretches mitigate inflammation at the bottom of your feet, helping to treat plantar fasciitis.

He is a seasoned professional who keeps on the cutting edge of new and innovative procedures and offers a full spectrum of chiropractic care for all ages.

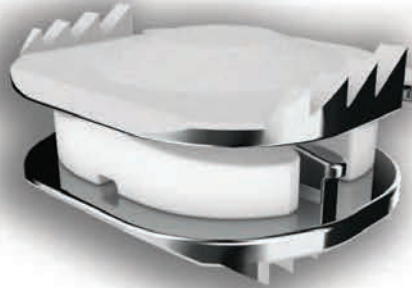

According to Zimmer Biomet, Mobi-C is the first cervical disc approved by the FDA for both one and two-level disc replacements. The FDA has determined that the Mobi-C disc replacement is better than fusion after seven years, for the two-level cervical disc replacement. Mobi-C had fewer subsequent surgeries after 84 months.



The center of rotation at each level of the cervical spine is variable and constantly changing. Mobi-C was designed to adapt to the instantaneous axis of rotation through its self-adjusting mobile core. It is designed to aid in motion similar to natural cervical spine motion. It moves with the spine.

Mobi-C's core is designed to create low stress at the implant-to-bone interface. There are no invasive screws, no bone removal for preparation and no additional operative steps. It is a one-step insertion with no drilling or chiseling needed.

Bartlesville Firefighter Chad Marshall, his wife, Ana; and their son, Creed; were recognized earlier this month for their heroic actions that helped save the life of their rural Osage County neighbor during a dog attack on April 18.

Off duty at the time, Chad and Ana, who is a pediatric nurse practitioner in Owasso, rushed to help the woman, with Ana covering the woman's body with her own while Chad fought the dog off of them.

Two other Good Samaritans stopped to help, with one man calling 911, and a woman positioning her vehicle between the victim and the dogs, which by then had abandoned the attack and fled.

The victim was hospitalized with serious injuries and both Chad and Ana were bitten multiple times. They were treated at a local after-hours clinic.



2020 G.O. Bonds Set for Sale

\$9 Million Tranche to Fund Several Projects

Completion of the City's 2021-22 audit has paved the way for the first issuance of \$16.4 million General Obligation Bond approved by voters in August 2020.

The City Council on Monday approved a resolution relating to the issuance of G.O. Bonds to provide \$9.5 million in funding for projects approved in the election. The remaining \$6.4 million will be issued next year.

"Completion of the City's 2021-22 Fiscal Year audit has allowed us to issue these bonds this fiscal year and ensures that we can keep our tax levy where it needs to be, so we appreciate the team effort it took to get this accomplished," said City Manager Mike Bailey.

Sale of the bonds is set for May 23 with closing scheduled for June 29, at which time the City will receive the funds.
